GRANT FOR SUMMER LANGUAGE STUDY ABROAD

You may apply for funds to study a modern foreign language in a country where the language is spoken on one of our Summer Study Abroad Programs. The money available from the fund does not cover the entire cost of a study abroad program, but is meant to encourage your study of foreign languages.

To be eligible you must have taken at least one course in the Department of Modern Languages and Cultures. Awards will be available for any of the languages taught in MLC. Funds are restricted to UR programs if they exist in a given language. You must submit a completed application to the Burton Committee by the deadline.
